Commissioner Kosinski: Good afternoon. I'd like to welcome everyone to the April 13th meeting of the New York State Board of Elections. My name is Peter Kosinski. I'm joined by Commissioners Henry Berger, Tony Casale, and Essma Bagnuola.

And today's meeting is for really one purpose only, and that's to review petitions. And there has been a finding by the staff on a number of the petitions that are before the Board this year. And I will ask the staff to just briefly outline what our task is here today.

Additionally, we held hearings on two specifications of objections for petitions for State Senate and Member of Assembly. Those findings are attached in your packet and, again, posted to the website.

Commissioner Kosinski: Are there any questions? I believe all four Commissioners have a copy of these determinations that the staff are recommending. And I would just entertain any questions that the Commissioners may have. I think we'll take these as a package unless the Commissioners would like to separate out any one of these items.
