Kathleen McGrath: We're good, Commissioner.

Commissioner Kosinski: Alright, great. Let's open the meeting. So we're going to start the meeting of the Board of Canvassers. There's a fix that has to be made to the certification that we made of the Presidential Primary, and maybe Kristen or Ray, you can explain exactly what this amendment is.

Raymond Riley: Sure, Commissioner, so we have two amendments to the certifications. The first amendment comes out of Herkimer County, there was an adjustment to their vote total score, both the Republican Primary and Presidential Primary out of several precincts, and the changes are reflected on the last page. Additionally, Tioga County had one adjustment to the Democratic presidential primary, a move of a void vote added one from a blank vote which they had incorrectly attributed previously. So, those changes are now reflected in the amended certification. It did not affect the results in any way. It did not affect any allocation of delegates in any way. So, we submit those to you for your approval.

Commissioner Kosinski: Ray, do you know the number of total votes that were changed here?

Raymond Riley: Sure, I do. For the Presidential Primary, Republican let's start there, the changes in Herkimer County: Chris Christie -12, Haley -22, Trump – 473, Blank – 1. For the Democratic Presidential Primary, out of Herkimer: Biden – 48, Williamson – 6, Philips – 7, Blank – 20, and as previously discussed, that Tioga blank -1, Void +1. And then for the Democratic Delegate contest out of Herkimer County: Monescalchi – 42, Clark – 38, Idleman – 43, Zagrobelny – 34, Boecher – 41, Blank – 207.

Commissioner Kosinski: Okay, thank you. Are there any other questions for the staff on this report? If not, I would entertain a motion for the Board of Canvassers to adopt the amended certification.

Commissioner Casale: So moved.

Commissioner Kosinski: So moved and seconded? All in favor aye?

Commissioner Bagnuola: Aye.

Commissioner Casale: Aye.

Commissioner Kosinski: Aye.

Commissioner Kosinski: Opposed? It's a unanimous vote 3 to 0 to adopt the amended certification, I believe that's the end of our meeting today unless there is some other business that needs to come before the Board of Canvassers? If not, I'll entertain a motion to adjourn until a future date, whenever we need a meeting.
