**BECOME A
POLL WORKER**



The Board of Elections is committed to fulfilling its responsibility to the citizens of New York State by providing fair, accurate, and accessible elections. This responsibility, and the credit associated with it, must be shared with the many dedicated poll workers who help make elections successful.



ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible to work as a poll worker, you must be a New York State registered voter. If you are 17 years old, you may be eligible if your school district participates in a program under Education Law Section 3207-a. Interpreters are eligible to work at poll sites regardless of registration status.

COMPENSATION

Poll workers get paid for training and for each day that they work.

NEW YORK STATE POLL WORKERS

- Prepare polling places for voting
- Set up the voting equipment
- Sign in and process voters
- Demonstrate voting procedures to voters
- Assist voters if requested
- Close the polling place
- Canvass and report the results
