**Minutes of the New York State Board of Elections  
Republican Commissioners Ballot Access Meeting  
Republican Presidential Primary Election**

**February 6, 2024**

A meeting of the Republican Commissioners of the New York State Board of Elections was held on February 6, 2024, at 10:00 a.m., to determine candidate ballot access for the April 2, 2024 Republican Presidential Primary Election.

Commissioners present were Anthony Casale, and Peter Kosinski. Staff members present were Raymond J. Riley III, Brendan Lovullo, Kevin Murphy, and Kathleen McGrath.

Raymond Riley reported on six candidates who filed certificates with supporting documents requesting ballot access as a nationally known candidate: Donald J. Trump, Chris Christie, Vivek Ramaswamy, Nikki Haley, Ryan Binkley and David Stuckenberg. Additionally, in the certificate for Nikki Haley, the candidate requested ballot access for meeting the requirements of matching funds.

On the basis of being a nationally known candidate, Commissioners Kosinski and Casale voted unanimously to grant ballot access to: Donald J. Trump, Nikki Haley, Chris Christie, and Vivek Ramaswamy.

Based on staff recommendations, Commissioners Kosinski and Casale voted unanimously to deny ballot access to: Ryan Binkley and David Stuckenberg, as they did not meet the standard for a nationally known candidate.

The New York State Board of Elections Republican Commissioners' meeting to determine ballot access for the ballot for the 2024 Presidential Primary adjourned, and the meeting of the New York State Board of Commissioners convened.
